English/Language Arts	4 credits	<b>English 9, English 10</b> , American Literature, British Literature, AP English Language and Composition, AP English Literature and Composition
Speech	1 credit <i>Classes of 2026 &amp; 2027 only</i>	The Speech requirement is fulfilled via online coursework (course name depends on offerings in Academic Seminar)
Social Studies	4 credits <i>Class of 2028 and later: 3</i>	AP U.S. History, AP U.S. Government & Politics, AP Macroeconomics, AP Microeconomics, AP World History, <b>Civics, Economics</b> , Sociology/Psychology, <b>U.S. History, World History &amp; Geography</b>
Bible	4 credits, 1 per year	<b>Bible 9, Bible 10, Bible 11, Bible 12</b>
Science	3 credits	Anatomy and Physiology, AP Biology, AP Physics 1, <b>Biology, either Chemistry or Conceptual Physics</b> (may also take both), Ecology
Business and Technology	1 credit, 0.5 credit of Personal Finance is required for Class of 2028 and later	Intro to Engineering Design, Personal Finance*, Principles of Engineering, Business Management, -Computer Science Essentials, and online options (via Academic Seminar**)
Physical Education	0.5 credit (3 years of middle school PE at OCS can count for PE credit)	Physical Education, Strength and Conditioning
Health Education	0.5 credit	<b>Health</b> is required for all high school students.
World Language	2 credits	American Sign Language I, II, III, and IV; Spanish I, II, III, and IV; AP Spanish Language and Culture
Fine and Performing Arts	1 credit	AP 2D Art & Design Portfolio, AP 3D Art & Design Portfolio, AP Drawing Portfolio, Praise Band, Intro to Digital Media/Digital Photography I, Drawing & Painting I, Mixed Media I, Mixed Chorus (HS Choir), Wind Ensemble (HS Band), Symphonic Band (HS Orchestra)
Additional Elective Courses	4 credits	Academic Seminar**, AP Seminar, AP Research, Topics in Film Studies, LEAD, Teacher's Aide, Writing for Publications: Yearbook, or other offered courses
