## Sweans Days 2023-24

Elementary Sweans Days (typically on Fridays) at OCS give variety to the school week for the students as well as acting as a fundraiser to support area charities and special projects in the Elementary school. Here is what you need to know about Sweans Days.

### What can my child wear for Sweans Day?

Students may wear neat jeans with no holes or embellishments on them, sweats without words on them, athletic shorts mid-thigh or longer, and any OCS spirit wear/Chapel shirt. **Leggings and tights are prohibited.**

### How do I pay for my child to participate in Sweans Day?

Teachers will log which students wear jeans or sweats each sweans days. Your child's participation will result in a \$1 charge per day being added to their FACTS bill at the end of the school year.

### Does my child have to participate in Sweans Day?

Students have the option to wear their normal uniform during sweans days. Students in uniform will not be charged the \$1 fee.

### Is every Friday a paid Sweans Day?

Sweans days are typically on Fridays, but we also celebrate various events or special occasions with FREE Sweans or Special Dress Days. Those will be communicated in advance through your teacher's weekly communication. See the below schedule for the Sweans Day fund allocations.
