

add.a.lingua L2 only timeline

(number of weeks spent in instruction)



AFTER their first day of school:

- **Second grade** students are expected to use L2 only to communicate with their teacher & peers

During the first **THREE** weeks of instruction **ONLY**:

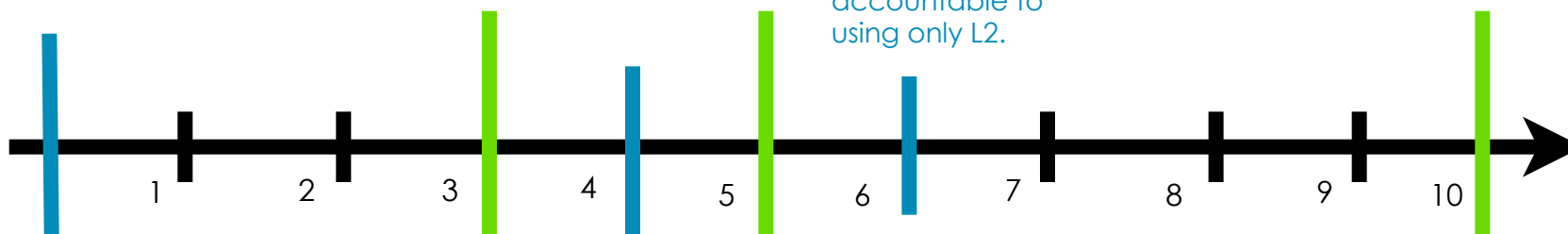
- **threeschool / preschool** instructors explain classroom routines/ instructions in English. L2 is used for actual content instruction. Answers in L2 or in English may be accepted.

After **SIX** weeks of instruction:

- **Kinder** teachers hold students accountable to using only L2.

After **TEN** weeks of instruction:

- **Kinder** students should begin to use L2 to speak to peers



ON their first day of school:

- **Third, fourth, and fifth grade** students are expected to use L2 only to communicate with their teacher & peers

After **FIVE** weeks of instruction:

- **First grade** students should begin to use L2 to speak with their peers

After **FOUR** weeks of instruction:

- **Kinder** teachers introduce circumlocution game, encouraging use of L2 only, even if students use only a couple words! Teacher will explain the game and incentives and practice for two weeks.
- **First grade** students are expected to use only L2 to communicate with their teacher.
