

Secondary Vocal Music Teacher

Position Purpose: To advance the mission of Oakland Christian School by supporting the continued development of an authentic Christ-centered community that intentionally cultivates Christ-like character in its students. The Fine Arts Department at OCS is dedicated to engaging students in classes and activities that build a spiritual foundation and biblical worldview. This position will teach a combination of middle school classes (Grades 6 – 8) and High School (Grades 9 – 11).

Position Description: This position includes teaching vocal music for middle school and high school students as well as teaching our middle school and high school praise and worship team. Duties include weekly chapel, seasonal evening performances at concerts and participation in festival. This position also includes coordination and directing of the annual high school drama production

Job Requirements: Candidates must be professing and maturing Christians enthusiastically supporting the school's statement of faith and mission statement. A bachelor's degree in a related field is required. The ideal candidate will have experience as a classroom teacher in a school setting with experience in classroom management, lesson planning, curriculum mapping, following pacing guides and conducting assessments for assigning report card grades.

Our Mission: Oakland Christian School is committed to providing excellence in education in an environment which is supportive of Bible-believing, Christ-centered families and their churches, and to nurturing individuals to become caring, contributing members of the body of Christ and Society.
