

SWEANS DAY GUIDELINES 6TH - 12TH GRADE

On certain days, typically on Fridays, throughout the school year, students will be allowed to wear sweans or jeans, and their OCS Spirit Wear for a fee, typically \$3.00. All of these days are intended to raise money for student-related programs. The event will determine the dollar amount for each day. Money will be collected during the first class of the morning from those who wish to participate. Please send the EXACT amount to make the payment process more efficient.

Money cannot be paid at the end of the day, only during the first class of the morning. Students and parents will be notified through Schoology announcements with the day of the week, the type of clothing, and the dollar amount before each event.

Please go over the SWEAN DAY and OCS SPIRIT WEAR dress code guidelines with your child:

- SWEANS are defined as loose-fitting sweatpants or jeans without ANY holes, designs, rips, tears, or fraying.
- OCS Spirit Wear is defined as apparel that is created, sold, or distributed by or through OCS. OCS hoodies may be worn, but the hood must not cover the head during the school day.
- Hats, coats, jackets, blankets, and pajama pants may not be worn during the school day.
- Shoes must have a full back and side. Crocs, sandals, slides etc. are not permissible on sweans days. or any other school day.
- Student athletes, if you are wearing your game day jersey and sweans you are still required to pay \$3.00.
- Only OCS uniform shorts are allowed to be worn on sweans days
