ACCESS - Tuition Assistance Program

OCS has contracted with SMART, LLC to provide their Financial Aid Analysis Service, SMART Aid. The SMART Aid link can be found on our website at www.oaklandchristian.com/tuition. SMART will collect all financial data from applicants, review and verify data and assess the need for aid. Applications must be fully completed by April 1, 2018 in order to be considered for assistance. A \$35 fee, paid via credit card only, is required to submit the application. OCS will notify applicants with scholarship determination by late-April.

2018-2019 Tuition Policies and Payment Options

New Student Applications and Re-enrollment: The \$150 application fee must accompany each new student application. Re-enrollment of current students for 2018-2019 begins at the January Parent Information Night. Any tuition balances for 2017-2018 must be paid in full by April 30, 2018 so that a student may be enrolled for 2018-2019. A non-refundable \$150 per student late fee will be charged to current families re-enrolling after May 1, 2018.

OCS 2018-2019 tuition is charged based on a 12-month cycle beginning May 1, 2018 and ending April 30, 2019.





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<u>NEW for 2018-2019!</u> OCS is moving to **online payments with FACTS** Management that will provide increased convenience and flexibility for our families. Details on how/when to sign up will be provided following reenrollment/enrollment. ALL families will be required to have a FACTS account for tuition and incidental fees throughout the year. *Enrollment is not complete until the family's FACTS account is set up.*

<u>Early Payment Discount:</u> Families are eligible for a 3% discount on tuition (fees excluded) when 2018-2019 tuition is paid in full and **received by Thursday, March 29, 2018** (<u>students must *first* be enrolled/re-enrolled online</u>). International tuition is not eligible for this discount.

Monthly Payment Plan: Tuition is billed monthly based on a 12-month cycle beginning May 1, 2018 and ending April 30, 2019. Payments are calculated by adding tuition charges <u>and FEES</u> for each student and dividing by 12. Families enrolling students after May 1, 2018 will be expected to make additional payments to catch up on those that were not made during summer months (May-August). <u>NEW for 2018-2019</u>: Tuition will be billed and collected by FACTS Management with payments made from checking or savings account via electronic funds transfer (EFT) or credit card (all initiated by FACTS), to be received on the 5th, 15th, or 25th day of each month.

<u>Late Payment Policy:</u> Payments received after the last day of a month will be considered late, and a \$50 monthly fee will be added to the family account. FACTS will assess a \$30 returned payment fee the first time an individual payment fails. All financial accounts must be kept up-to-date in order for students to continue their education at OCS. Children of families whose accounts fall more than 60 days behind may be prevented from attending school.

<u>Refunds:</u> Refunds of tuition paid will be made for the months <u>following</u> withdrawal. Families withdrawing a student after acceptance and/or re-enrollment are responsible for all payments due through the month a withdrawal takes place, <u>even if</u> classes are not yet in session. Attendance during part of a month is considered a full month for refund purposes.

Before and After School Childcare (OMEGA)

OMEGA is available before and after regularly scheduled class times for all enrolled students, EEC - 8th grade. OMEGA is billed separately from tuition at the end of each month at a prorated amount of \$6.25 per hour, per child. There is a multi-child discount. Hours of operation are M-F, 7a.m. until 6p.m. Late pick-ups after 6p.m. will be billed at \$1/minute.

Family Service Hours (FSH)

Each family is required to participate in the Family Service Hours (FSH) program. Families in K–12th grade must complete a total of 20 FSH and families in the EEC must complete a total of 10 FSH per school year. The FSH program for the 2018-2019 school year begins on May 1, 2018 and ends on April 30, 2019. A \$20 fee will be charged for every hour not completed.
